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Why is the Housing Supply Still So Low?

The imbalance between the demand for homes to buy and available inventory has been going on for a while now. The result is a strong seller's market where buyers are left asking, "Why am I having such a hard time finding a home?"

What's causing the current housing supply crisis? There are two key reasons why inventory is still so low:

1. New Home Construction Fell Behind For Several Years

During the housing bubble in 2005, builders exceeded the long-term average of housing units, which in conjunction with other factors, resulted in an oversupply of homes. The oversupply of homes was one of the factors that led to the housing crash in 2008. Since then, new home construction still hasn't gotten back on track. For the last 13 years, builders haven't been able to construct enough homes to meet the historical average, leaving a multi-year inventory deficit going into the pandemic. And here in our area, new construction isn't going to provide more inventory as there's not much space left to build.

2. The Pandemic's Effect on the Housing Market

When the pandemic hit in 2020 and everyone had to stay home, it fueled a renewed focus on the meaning of home. Many people wanted larger homes since they were spending so much time there. And interest rates below 3% fueled the demand as many potential home buyers decided it was a great time to buy a new place. Simultaneously, some homeowners who might have chosen to sell were reluctant to put their homes on the market because of feelings of uncertainty.

Is the low inventory market expected to continue? Some say more homes may be hitting the market this year. "We expect that we'll start to see a turnaround and inventory will stabilize and start to go up a little bit in 2022," said Danielle Hale, chief economist at Realtor.com.

- Spray bottle
- Small funnel
- 1/2 cup white vinegar
- 2 tablespoons baking soda
- Tea tree essential oil
- Eucalyptus essential oil

Instructions:

- Take the top off of an empty spray bottle, place a small funnel into the opening and pour in 1/2 cup of white vinegar.
- Add 2 tablespoons of baking soda, and wait for the foaming to subside.
- 3. Add in 10 drops each of tea tree and eucalyptus essential oil.
- 4. Fill the rest of the bottle with water.
- Screw the spray top onto the bottle, and shake well before use.
