

THE MARKET SNAPSHOT

7,200 single-family homes are on the market without offers (+37% year-over-year).

Condos & townhomes inventory surged 56% higher compared to last year.

Sales volume: down 14% for single-family and 15% for condos/townhomes.

Median home price: \$480,000, only slightly softer than the \$485,000 peak.

Days on market: creeping into the 50s, giving buyers more negotiating power.



The real estate market is heading into fall/winter with more balance than we've seen in years. As of August 2025:

Looking ahead: all eyes are on the Federal Reserve this fall. A rate adjustment could be the spark that brings buyers off the sidelines and back into the market heading into 2026.



Fall and winter are when locals love the desert most. Temperatures dip into the 70s during the day, nights are crisp, and the mountains glow golden at sunset. Hiking at Red Rock Canyon or Sloan Canyon becomes an easy Saturday routine, while Sunday mornings are for golf, farmers' markets, or simply walking the dog under clear desert skies.

But here's something many people don't realize: Las Vegas has skiing. Head just 45 minutes north and you'll find Lee Canyon, a local ski resort offering everything from beginner runs to terrain parks. For those living in Skye Canyon or near Kyle Canyon Road, skiing is practically in their backyard —making it one of the most unique lifestyle perks of Northwest Las Vegas.

Insider tip: if you're considering moving here, plan a visit between October and February. You'll see firsthand why locals brag about "sweater weather season" in Las Vegas—where you can hike, golf, and even ski, all in the same weekend.
