The Pearl Historic District

The Pearl Historic District is one of my all-time favorite places to be - I actually lived here for a short time. The Pearl was formerly an actual brewery from the 1880's until 1999 when it was shut down and abandoned for several years. In 2012, the area was completely renovated and parts were restored to make it what it is today. I think of the Pearl as the "Real" San Antonio Riverwalk! It is much nicer down here.

This area has become increasingly popular for young adults to call home as it is centrally located in the city, close to downtown, close to the airport, and close to the major interchanges.
